Mike と Cindy の会話を読み、各問に答えなさい。

Mike and Cindy are talking about \*Prince Phillip, the Duke of Edinburgh. He was the husband of Queen Elizabeth II, the British queen.

Mike : On the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 2021, Prince Phillip, the Duke of Edinburgh died at the age of 99.

Cindy : Yes, it was very sad. Actually, he was born in \*Greece, and his father was a prince of Greece and Denmark. His uncle was the king of Greece.

Mike : Yes, but not for very long. He gave up his \*throne in 1922, and all the family members left Greece when Phillip was only 18 months old.

Cindy : He went to school in France and Germany. Then he went to the UK and there he met Elizabeth II.

Mike : It was a long time ago. He met her in 1934 when he was 13 years old and she was only eight.

Cindy : She fell in love with him five years later. And they started writing letters to ( A ).

Mike : They got married shortly after the Second World War.

Cindy : Yes, he was asked to marry her in 1946, but they didn't get married until the next year because the king wanted her to wait until she was 21. She was still very young.

Mike : When they got married at Westminster Abbey in 1947, it was recorded and \*broadcast by \*the BBC radio and listened to by 200 million people around the world.

Cindy : Yes, and they received 2,500 wedding guests from around the world. They were married for over 70 years. It's the longest marriage of any British king and queen.

Mike : Elizabeth actually became the queen in 1952 when her father died and she was only 25 years old then.

Cindy : She became queen but Prince Phillip always stayed Prince Phillip. He never became king. He didn't \*rule and he had no power.

Mike : Yes, she was the queen. The king was her father, so she is the queen.

Cindy : His job was to support the queen. I think everyone thinks he did a good job. What do you think he is most famous ( B )?

Mike : I think the biggest thing is \*the Duke of Edinburgh Award. He gave young people aged between 18 to 25 various awards for volunteer activities.

Cindy : This is very popular, isn't it? I think over one million young people take part in this program, in more than 130 countries.

Mike : I think most people would certainly say that he is an honest \*gentleman.

## 3

Most people think that the capital of the movie world is Hollywood, in the United States. However, the real movie capital is Mumbai, in India. Before 1995, Mumbai was known as Bombay, so the movie industry there is often called “Bollywood.” Bollywood makes twice as many movies each year as Hollywood — more than 1,000 movies a year.

(A) Bollywood movies { ① from / ② made / ③ different / ④ are / ⑤ very / ⑥ in Hollywood / ⑦ the movies }. For one thing, Bollywood movies are longer than most Hollywood movies. Most Bollywood movies are more than three hours long, and contain singing, dancing, action, adventure, and mystery. Because Bollywood movies contain so many different features, this type of movie is sometimes called a “masala” movie — “masala” is an Indian word for a mixture of spices.

Another big difference between Bollywood and Hollywood movies is how the movies are made. It takes longer to make a movie in Hollywood than in Bollywood. In fact, filming may begin on a Bollywood movie before the script is even finished. The writers can make up the story while they are making the movie. Sometimes they will even write the script by hand instead of taking time to type it.

## 4

Almost all cultures ※celebrate the end of one year and the beginning of another in some way. Different cultures celebrate the beginning of a new year in different ways, and at different times on the calendar.

In ※Western countries, people usually celebrate New Year at midnight on December 31<sup>st</sup> / January 1<sup>st</sup>. People may go to parties, sometimes wearing formal clothes. During the first minutes of the new year, people wish each other happiness. But some cultures like to celebrate the new year by ( 1 ) up early to watch the sunrise. They welcome the new year with the first light of the sunrise.

It is also a Western ※custom to make a New Year's ※promise. It is called a resolution. New Year's resolutions usually ※include promises to try something new or ( 2 ) a bad ※habit.

Many cultures also do special things to ※get rid of bad luck at the beginning of a new year. For example, in Ecuador, families make a big doll from old clothes. The doll is filled with old newspapers and ※firecrackers. At midnight, these dolls are burned to show the bad things from the last year are gone and the new year can start ※afresh. Other ※traditions to keep ( 3 ) bad luck for the new year include throwing things into rivers or the sea, or saying special things on the first day of the new year.

Other New Year traditions are followed to bring good luck for the new year. For example, people in Spain eat grapes on New Year's Day for good luck. In France, they eat pancakes for good luck. In the United States, some people eat ※black-eyed peas at New Year for good luck — but to get good luck all through the year, you have to eat 365 of them!
