

Maria and Luke are talking about two famous kinds of trees in Brazil.

- Maria : Fifty percent of Brazil is covered in forest. There are two kinds of famous Brazilian trees, the Brazilwood tree and the Brazil nut tree.
- Luke: Now I know about Brazil nuts but I've never heard of the Brazilwood tree. Is that an **Amazon rainforest tree?
- Maria: No, Luke, it's a tree that grew along the ^{**}coast of Brazil hundreds of years ago. It was very popular with the early ^{**}Portuguese explorers.
- Luke : You said "grew," so does that mean it's (A) extinct?
- Maria: No, we can still see them, but there are not so many Brazilwood trees now as in the past. The trees were cut down because they produced a wonderful red ^{**}dye. Because the trees were so important at that time, the country's name comes from the tree.
- Luke : Ah. I didn't know that.
- Maria : Actually, Brazil is the only country ^{*}named after a tree.
- Luke : Next is the Brazil nut tree. Where did that name come from?
- Maria: The Brazil nut tree is named after the country.
- Luke : Is that an Amazon rainforest tree?
- Maria : Yes, it is, and it's one of the biggest. It grows up to 50 meters tall.
- Luke : That's tall.
- Maria: The **trunk of the tree is very tall, and the **branches are near the top, and the fruit, which has the nuts in, is at the top of the tree. And the fruit is the size of a baseball . . .
- Luke : Wow.
- Maria : It *weighs two kilos and that falls from up to 50 meters. It falls at 80 km/hr.
- Luke : So you don't want to be (\mathbf{B}) the tree when that happens.

Sharks are *cold-blooded like most fish. (A) Their body *temperature $\{$ ① according to / ② around / ③ the water / ④ changes / ⑤ them $\}$. Most sharks stay near the ocean's surface where it is warmer. But, *scalloped hammerhead sharks dive deep into the cold parts of the ocean for food. Scientists from a university in Hawaii found that these sharks don't use their (B) gills and stop *breathing to stay warm.

(C) The scientists $\{ (1) \text{ on } / (2) \text{ in } / (3) \text{ put } / (4) \text{ scalloped hammerhead sharks } / (5) \text{ special sensors } \}$ <u>Hawaii.</u> This helped them record the shark's body heat and the water temperature around it. They could also check how deep the shark swam.

The sharks went deep diving many times. They dove about 800m to waters that were 5 degrees Celsius (°C). There, the sharks ate for about four minutes. Then, they returned to the surface. The shark's body stayed warm while diving. It only cooled when the shark came closer to the surface.

The scientists had a ^{*}theory. The sharks stopped heat ^{*}loss by closing their gills. Going upward, they opened their gills to breathe again. So, their body cooled as they got closer to the surface.

Research from 2015 * confirmed this. The video showed the sharks swimming into very deep water with their gills closed. But, their gills were open at the water's surface.

This *behavior mostly helps these sharks. But *deep-sea mining, *habitat loss and *overfishing can put them in danger.

Cup ramen serves as a perfect food when disasters happen. It is easy to send and can be made (1). In 2013, when Typhoon Haiyan hit the Philippines, (2) 40 million people were **affected. They needed food quickly. They were **comforted by 50 million cups of hot noodles. After ** the Great East Japan Earthquake, people in the disaster areas had to survive the cold winter in ** shelters. They were given cup ramen by volunteers. The hot and tasty cup ramen warmed them up and "** revived" them.

Have you ever thought how cup ramen is made? This *product has many clever ideas in it.

The noodles are put in the middle of the cup. Do you know why it is made in this way? It allows the hot water to *spread through the noodles *evenly. Then they all become (3) and tasty.

When hot water is poured in, tasty vegetables, egg, and meat float to the surface like magic. These *ingredients are made by "freeze drying." Cup ramen was the first product to use this process for food.

These are just two of the many clever ideas used in cup ramen. It is not (4) that cup ramen is called one of the greatest ^{*}inventions from Japan.

The idea for "Instant ramen" started in the 1940s. It was a time when many Japanese people *suffered from hunger. In Osaka, a man named Ando Momofuku saw long lines of people at ramen shops. "If ramen becomes easy to cook at home, then many people will feel happy," he thought.

"If the noodles are dried, they can be kept for a long time. It would be a wonderful instant food," he thought. But he couldn't understand how to dry them well. One day, his wife was cooking tempura. He got an ^{**}inspiration. He fried boiled noodles in hot oil. This was an important step in making his dream come true.

"Instant ramen" soon spread over the country. Later, in the 1970s, he ^{*}hit upon the idea of (5) instant ramen into a cup. So, people could enjoy hot and tasty ramen anywhere. These days, over 100 ^{*}billion cups are eaten every year by people all over the world.
