George and Naomi are talking about ※migrating birds.

Naomi : There are about 10,000 known bird ※species around the world, and half of these migrate.

George : Yes. So, why do they do it, and how?

Naomi : It's amazing. There are birds that fly 90,000 km from ※the north pole to ※the south pole every year. It's unbelievable!

George : Yes, but some of them go over the Himalayas, which are 7,000 m high.

Naomi : Yes. The ※record for the longest non-stop ※flight by birds is over 12,000 km in 11 days.

George : I see, but some penguins walk 13,000 km every year.

Naomi : Yes, some amazing numbers there. So, why do they do it? There are two reasons. The first is food and the second is finding good places to ※nest.

George : A good example is ※ospreys from Scotland. They live in West Africa in winter. It is warm and there's a lot of fish for them.

Naomi : Yes, they migrate between north and south. Scotland has more ※daylight hours in summer : six hours longer than West Africa. There's more chance to catch fish. So, they fly to Scotland in spring.

George : And then when it gets cold, do they return south?

Naomi : Yes. And forests in Scotland are good for nesting. In Scotland there are few ※predators.

George : After nesting, what do they do?

Naomi : At the end of summer, the female osprey flies south alone. The male stays and keeps ※feeding ※the young, and then he leaves to go south. Finally, the young begin to migrate alone.

George : Wow!

Naomi : After their first flight to Africa, the young don't return for the first three summers. And then they'll return to Scotland.

George : Well, birds know their ※flyways. Most birds stop and rest ※along the way. It seems they use (A) ※visual cues. So, they are the sun and rivers during the day.

Naomi : Also, they use the stars and the moon at night. But also birds have a ※magnetic compass inside them to ※navigate. We know this from the birds that have ※GPS tags on them.

George : And Scottish ospreys use the ※thermals to fly high over land. It's about a 45-day trip to West Africa.

Naomi : Wonderful.

On February 22, 2024, *the Odysseus spacecraft landed near the Moon's south pole. This was a *crewless *mission. Odysseus was made and flown by an American *private company. An American spacecraft went to the Moon for the first time in 1972, and (A) it is { ① the Moon / ② spacecraft / ③ land / ④ on / ⑤ private / ⑥ to / ⑦ the first }.

The landing was hard for the *mission control team. When the spacecraft got close to the Moon, the team lost *contact with it. They thought that it was *damaged. After 15 minutes, the team finally got a *signal from the spacecraft. (B) This told them that Odysseus landed on the Moon.

Soon after landing, (C) Odysseus { ① send back / ② started / ③ to Earth / ④ to / ⑤ data }. The company thought the spacecraft landed *upright. But later, the company said that it fell down during the landing. It was *lying on its side. They believed the spacecraft would still finish its week-long mission.

But on February 26, 2024, the company said that Odysseus could only work when the Sun shined on its *solar panels. (D) This will continue to *happen until the morning of February 27, 2024. After that, the spacecraft will stop working.

*NASA thinks the mission was a success. It shows that NASA can work with private companies to land spacecraft on the Moon.

The first Olympics were held in ※ancient Greece. In ancient Greece, athletes competed in sports like running and triple jump. Today, the ※modern Olympics have many more sports, including summer and winter events.

Countries are good at different sports. For example, Kenya is famous for its long-※distance runners, and Norway is great at winter sports like skiing. But the Olympics are not just about winning. They are about celebrating hard work, and never ※giving up.

Watching sports brings people closer (4), ※whether they are cheering for the same team or different teams. The Olympics are special because they give people around the world a chance to ※unite and enjoy sports together.

Hosting the Olympics is a big ※honor for any country. It's a chance to welcome the world and show their culture, ※technology, and kindness. When a city hosts the Olympics, it usually improves (5) buildings and ※tourism, but it also costs a lot of money to build stadiums and hotels.

The Olympics ※inspire people to dream and work hard to ※achieve their goals. Whether you are an athlete or a fan, the Olympics celebrate what we can do through hard work and teamwork. How do the Olympic Games inspire you?
