**Another rare lobster was also found. On July 21, 2024, a *fisherman caught a colorful lobster. It was pink, **purple, and blue. This is much more rare than finding an orange one! The lobster now lives at a **science center.

Lobsters are found in oceans all over the world. Their *shells have *a mix of red, blue, and yellow *pigments. This gives the shell a brown color. But sometimes, the colors mix *differently. So some lobsters have different colors.

A lobster's brain is in its throat. Its teeth are in its stomach. And its *kidneys are in its head! They use their legs to hear. They use their feet to taste food. Lobsters can live for about 50 years.

Taking care of the environment is becoming more important because **climate change is affecting our planet. People around the world are trying to help the Earth by recycling, using less plastic, and saving power. Have you thought about what you can do to help the environment?

There are many small things we can do in our daily lives to reduce waste. For example, instead of using plastic bags, we can bring our own bags when we go shopping. Instead of driving, we can walk, ride a bike, or take *public buses to (1) *fuel and reduce *pollution.

Recycling is another way to help the environment. Many people *sort their trash into different types like paper, plastic, and glass. This helps increase the amount of *waste we recycle, reduces the amount of waste in *landfills, and allows *materials to be reused.

But climate problems can be different in different places. In some parts of the world, the biggest problem is not having enough water. In other areas, having too much rain is a bigger problem. Each *region has its own challenges when protecting the environment.

Even small actions can help. For example, turning (2) lights when you leave a room or *unplugging electronics when not in use can save a lot of energy over time.

Governments and companies are also working together to find new ways to solve environmental problems. Many countries have signed *agreements to (3) pollution, and companies are creating new ideas for cleaner energy, like wind and *solar power.

In schools, students are learning why it is important to *protect the Earth. Environmental education helps young people understand the *effect their actions can have and *encourages them to *take responsibility for the future of the Earth.

Each of us can help protect the environment (4) future *generations. Whether it's by recycling, saving energy, or using public buses, we can all help the Earth. What can you (5) to protect the environment today?
