## 2

Our lifestyles are changing, even basic ones like where we eat. Rina and George are talking about where we have our meals when we're at home.

George : Well, we nearly always eat at the kitchen table, don't we?

Rina : Of course. We have a table and chairs and we have breakfast, lunch and dinner there.

George : Yes. But when it gets warmer in summer, there's a table and bench in the garden. So we eat outside, even in the evening when it's warm.

Rina : But we usually eat outside during lunchtime.

George : Yes.

Rina : It is normal for us, but do you know that in Britain only 18% of families eat their meals sitting at a table?

George : I can't believe that.

Rina : I know. But can you guess where 34% of families eat their meals?

George : Um..., let me see. Watching TV on the sofa!

Rina : Yes. But we don't do that very often, but we eat in the living room.

George : But only when we're watching a football match.

Rina : Yes. Another popular place is in bed. Breakfast in bed. It sounds like a nice idea!

George : No, thank you. I don't think (A) it's good for me.

Rina : Anyway, for many cultures, having meals on the floor is very normal. Many people in Asian countries do that.

George : Yes. I remember that in Asia and in the Middle East. When I went there, I had a lot of meals on the floor. (B) It was a little uncomfortable for me.

Rina : Well, often there are \*cushions. And you were sitting at a low table, weren't you?

George : Yes, my legs were crossed.

Rina : Yes. But we sometimes sit on the ground.

George : Yes, on the grass. When we're having a picnic.

Rina : Exactly. I think it's very ( C ) to sit on the grass.

George : And they say that it's better for the \*digestion.

Rina : They also say that it makes the food better when you're sitting on the grass.

George : Yes. I think so.

Rina : Where is another popular place, not in the home, George?

## 3

We have learned a lot about life on the Earth. We know that terrible <sup>※</sup>disasters often happen, and when they do, they can cause lots of deaths. We now know that such a disaster killed the <sup>※</sup>dinosaurs and that there have been many others.

So some people worry about <sup>※</sup>whether humans can continue to live on the Earth. They want <sup>※</sup>humanity to be able to live on other <sup>※</sup>planets. That way, if something serious happens on the Earth, we will be able to live somewhere else. To do that, we will need to build homes on other planets, but where?

The Moon and the planets Mars and Venus are the nearest to the Earth, but they are not very good for human life. We will surely visit Mars and the Moon again, but it may be difficult to build a place to live there. To do that, { ① to / ② will need / ③ a place / ④ and water / ⑤ we / ⑥ air / ⑦ make }, grow food, and find different kinds of <sup>※</sup>materials for making things.

Recently, scientists have discovered that some of the large moons around Jupiter and Saturn may be good places for humans to live. Saturn's moon Titan has a lot of <sup>※</sup>oxygen and is made of rock and ice, just like the Earth. Although it is very cold ( about  $-180^{\circ}\text{C}$  ), it also has many useful materials.

Jupiter's moons have a lot of oxygen and water under ice. While they are far from the sun, they both have a hot center; this stops the water inside from becoming ice and can be used for power.

These moons are far from the Earth, so they are not easy to reach. Even if we get there, we cannot be sure if we can live there. But, perhaps we should try — our children may thank us for it!

People have made <sup>※</sup>graffiti for thousands of years. <sup>※</sup>Explorers have found them in ancient Egypt, in Roman cities, and even on <sup>※</sup>cave walls. Today, we can see colorful spray-painted graffiti on the walls of almost every large city around the world. Some see graffiti as a kind of art, but many others call it <sup>※</sup>vandalism.

People who don't like graffiti say that it is simply vandalism. They may be right; after all, if you paint your house, you won't like it if someone comes at night and paints something on your wall — especially if they paint words you don't agree ( 1 ), or an image you don't like. It's true that graffiti damages people's <sup>※</sup>property.

On the other hand, graffiti can be artistic, funny, or have an important message. This kind of graffiti is loved by many people. The <sup>※</sup>mysterious artist Banksy, ( 2 ) example, has become very well known for his or her graffiti. Banksy's work often carries a sharp <sup>※</sup>political message. Banksy's art pieces are sometimes taken away and sold for a lot of money.

People who support graffiti art say that it adds beauty to a place. This is especially true in poorer, dirtier places. In such places, graffiti can give a voice to young people. Supporters of graffiti say that we should help young artists. They say we should not try to ( 3 ) young artists.

Maybe the most important thing to remember about graffiti is that it is not all the same. In some cases, graffiti is ( 4 ), but in others, it is <sup>※</sup>mere vandalism. Just like any other art, some graffiti is good, and some graffiti is bad. We should look at each piece with an open mind.
